Doctoral Degree Level

1. Applicants for doctoral programs must submit one of the following English proficiency test results:

(7) Students must pass 2 graduate-level English language courses, as follows:

Students taking the RT-TEP test for the first time will receive it free of charge from the university.

Students can submit English proficiency test scores that meet the graduation criteria when applying for admission. These scores can also be used to request graduation, even if they are more than 2 years old from the date of announcement.

Master's Degree Level

1. To complete the master's degree, students must meet one of the following English proficiency test results:

Students taking the RT-TEP test for the first time will receive it free of charge from the university.

The English proficiency test results, required for the completion of the master's degree program, must be no older than 2 years from the date of the test result announcement until the submission date to the university.
